

IFFPSS Fellowship Rules

Certain special rules apply to graduate fellows of the IFFPSS who are taking the June 24-25, 2023, ABFPRS examination to fulfill IFFPSS Fellowship educational requirements. IFFPSS fellowship applicants must sit for the examination the year the fellowship is completed unless a written request for deferment is granted by the International Board for Certification in Facial Plastic Surgery (IBCFPRS) Credentials Committee. The IBCFPRS Credentials Committee may grant deferment two times.

Upon passing the examination, IFFPSS fellowship candidates have up to five years to accumulate the minimum number of points for training/experience to complete certification requirements for IBCFPRS. For a former IFFPSS graduate fellow to be considered for certification during the 2023 certification cycle, a completed application must be postmarked no later than December 1, 2022. An IFFPSS graduate fellow does not receive IBCFPRS certification until he/she has completed all requirements.
